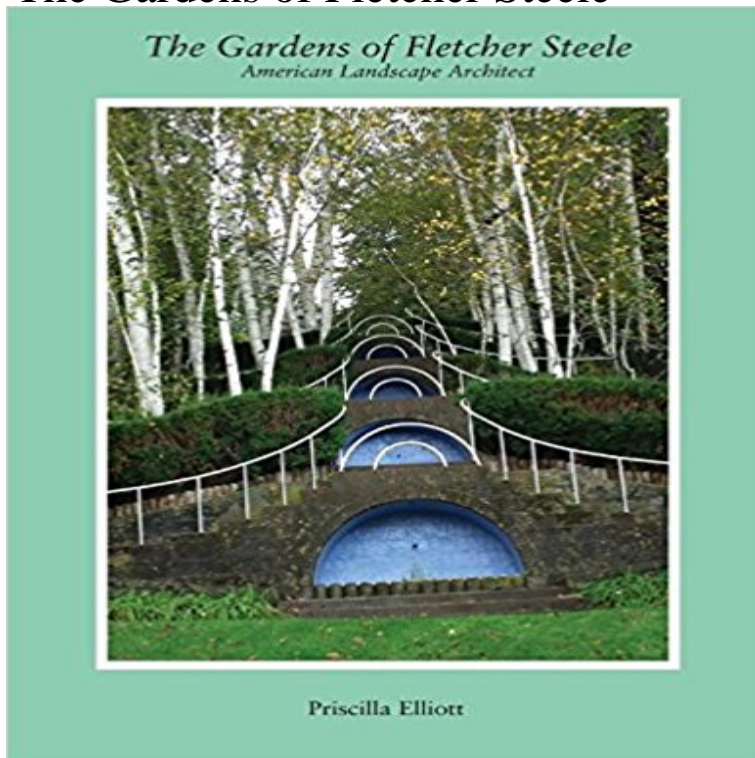


The Gardens of Fletcher Steele
