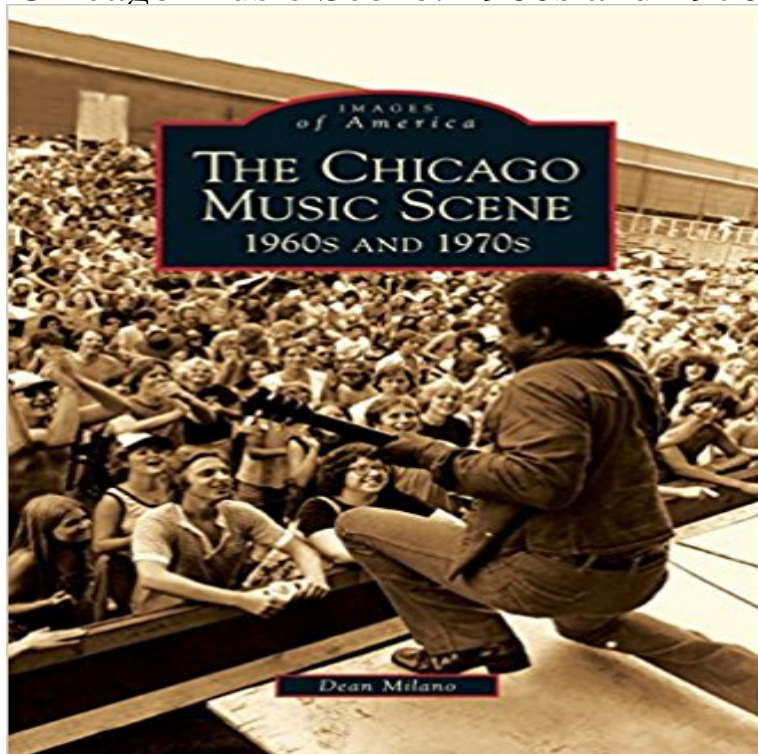


Chicago Music Scene: 1960s and 1970s
