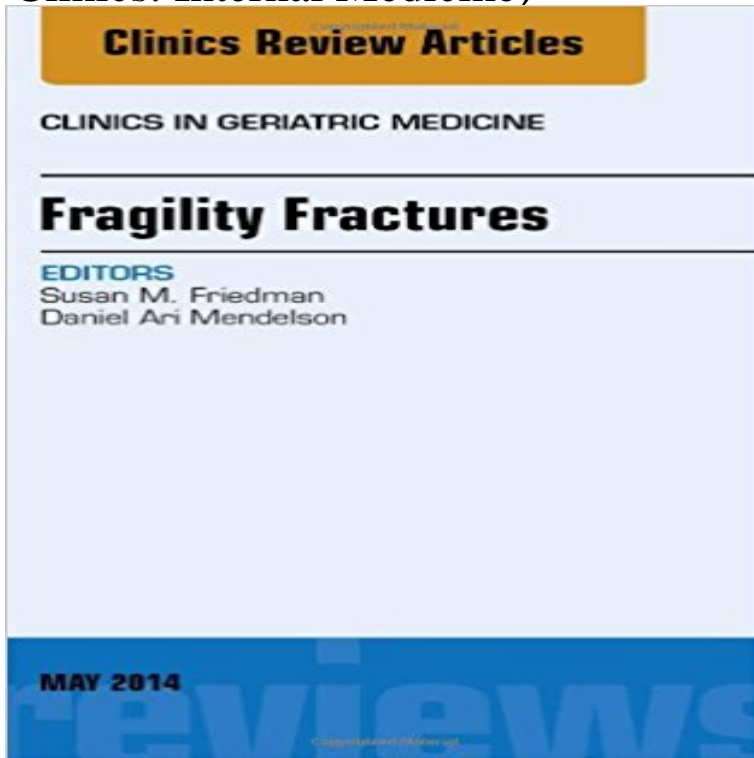


Fragility Fractures, An Issue of Clinics in Geriatric Medicine, 1e (The Clinics: Internal Medicine)



This issue of Clinics in Geriatric Medicine is centered on the management of the geriatric fragility fracture patient.
