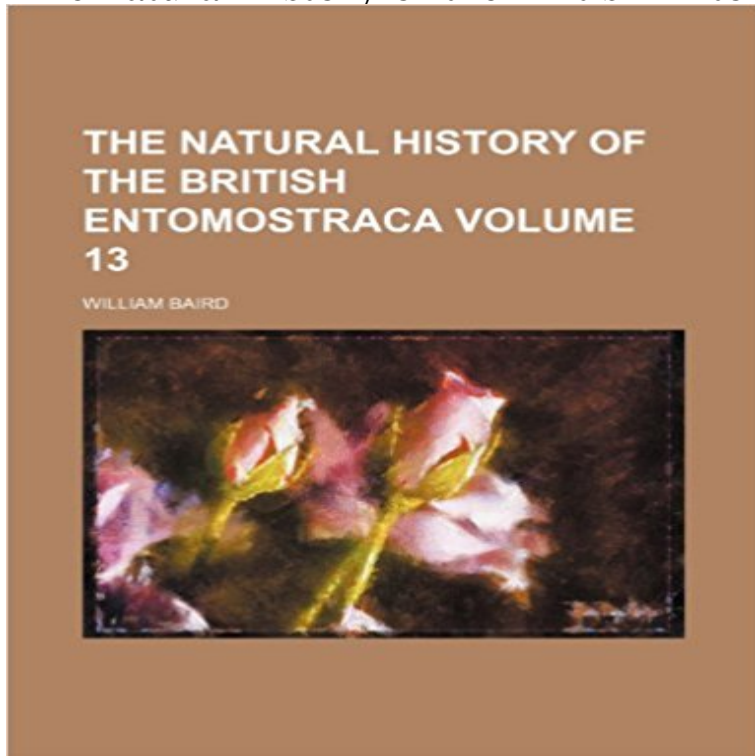


## The natural history of the British Entomostraca Volume 13

Not illustrated. 1850 Excerpt: ...He gives a figure of it also, which, though far from being correct, suffices to show us that his insect is likewise the *Cyclops quadricornis*. His observations upon it are very interesting, and he discovered, among other things worthy of note, the great difference there is between the young and the old animals, though he did not carry his observations so far as to trace the transformations which take place. In Number 283 of the *Philosophical Transactions* for January and February, 1703, the same author gives a description of a polype (the *Hydra viridis* of Midler) growing upon the *1cm n a*, or duck-weed, which calls forth another paper from an anonymous correspondent, in Number 288, for November and December, 1703, in which the writer mentions his having frequently observed the same polype growing upon insects, especially upon two sorts, of the crustaceous kind. Of these two species of animals, which he states are monocolous he gives figures, sufficiently correct to show them to be the *Cyclops quadricornis* and *Diaptomus Castor*, the first being a tolerable figure, though the second is very indifferent. The same writer also takes notice of a third animal of the same family, which is much smaller, and like a shrimp, but which he could never figure, evidently the *Canthocainptus minutus*. Baker, in his *Microscope made Easy*, 1743, makes a few remarks upon the same animals, and copies the figures from the *Philosophical Transactions*; and in his *Employment for the Microscope*, 1764, he publishes a letter from a correspondent, who gives a variety of details with regard to the animal which Leeuwenhoek describes, finds great fault with his figure, but gives a much worse one
