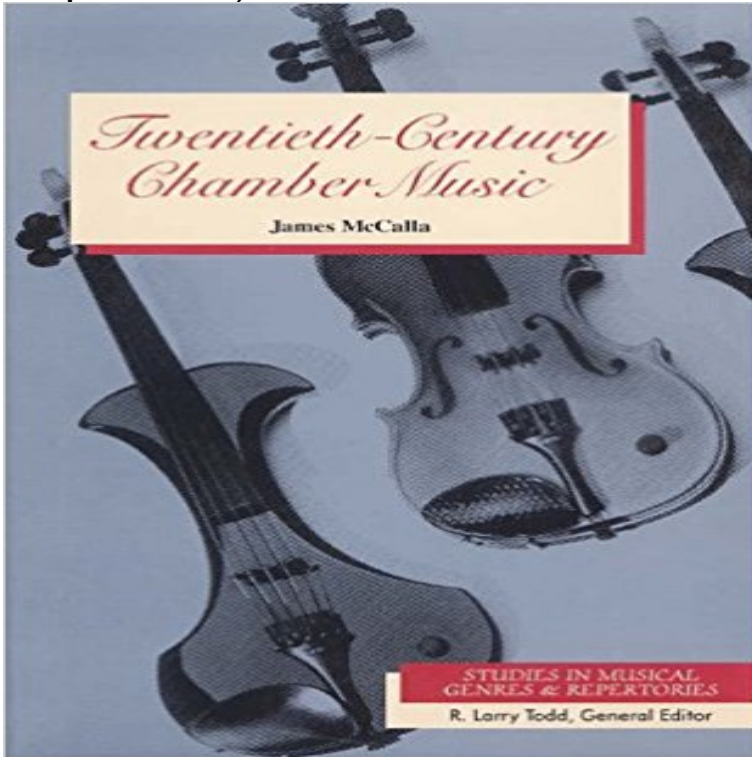


## Twentieth-Century Chamber Music (Studies in Musical Genres and Repertories)
