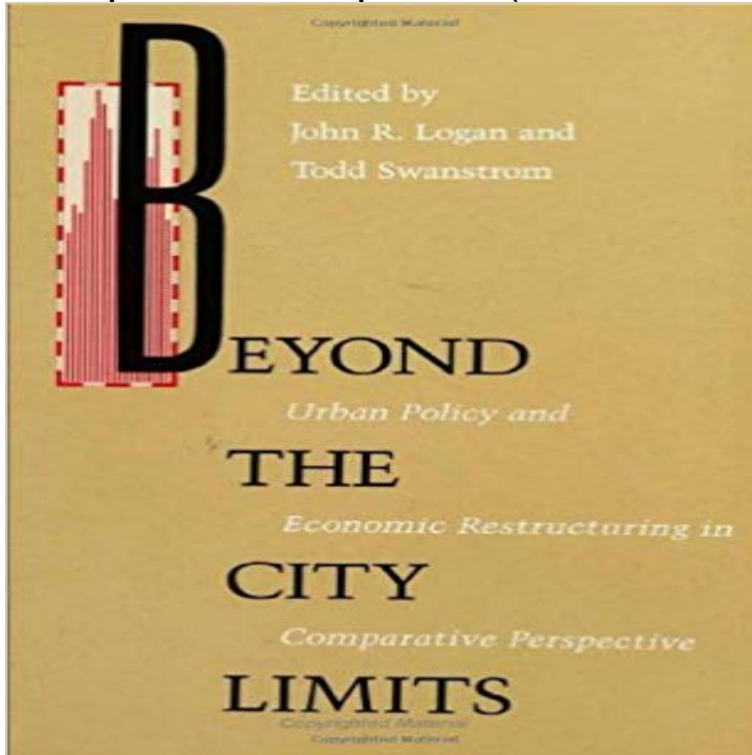


# Beyond City Limits: Urban Policy and Economic Restructuring in Comparative Perspective (Conflicts In Urban & Regional Development)
